

We are now at the half way mark of the season, results so far after 12 race nights 10 overall wins 1 second overall, 1 back of pack finish along with 2 race nights cancelled due to weather.

BK Super Saloon Pro Dirt Series

Only 3 of the 9 rounds have been raced so far, rounds 1 and 2 cancelled due to weather with wins in round 3 and 5 and a second in round 4, we currently are leading the series overall.

New Zealand Champs

Night one after 3 heats finished top of group.

Night two finals night and mechanical gremlins set in not once but twice only recording a 2nd place in the second race and DNF's in race one and three. Truly the low point of this season so far.

New Zealand Grand Prix

Night one finished top of group. Night two finals night, finished top overall, then won the NZGP final. Mark became the first Super Saloon Driver to win the NZGP 3 years in a row.

We now head to Palmerston North on 6th & 7th of February for round 6 of the BK Super Saloon Pro Dirt Series, this is held on the second night of the Super Stock Team Champs in front of a sold out crowd of 17500 people each night. We have also been asked to display our car alongside BK cars on Friday morning/afternoon in the town square during the Superstock car safety checking this draws a crowd of around 4/5000 every year so is a great promo opportunity for us.
